



Postdoctoral Position at Ohio University Theoretical High–Energy Astrophysics

Applications are requested for a postdoc position in high–energy astrophysics. The selected candidate will work with Prof. Markus Böttcher at Ohio University on models for the theoretical interpretation of high–energy emission from blazars. A Ph.D. in physics/astronomy and a strong background in computational high–energy astrophysics are required. Although the research will be primarily theoretical, an interest in observations and the coordination of multiwavelength campaigns would be desirable. Also, a commitment to working effectively with students, faculty and staff from diverse backgrounds is required.

The position is initially for one year, but may be extended up to three years, depending on performance and availability of funding. Starting date is negotiable, but can be as early as December 1, 2009.
