*Time (s) is the amount of seconds that symbols persist after the actual flash.

+CG – Positive Cloud-to-Ground Stroke – Rare strike that makes contact with the ground and has a positive polarity. These are a good indicator of a severe thunderstorm.

-CG – Negative Cloud to Ground Stroke – Most common strike that makes contact with the ground and has a negative polarity.

+IC – Positive Intra-Cloud/Inter-Cloud Stroke – Stroke that is contained within one cloud or from one cloud to another. These have a positive polarity.

-IC – Negative Intra-Cloud/Inter-Cloud Stroke – Stroke that is contained within one cloud or from one cloud to another with negative polarity. A high number of these indicate a severe thunderstorm.

+CID – Positive Compact Inter-Cloud Discharge – Single stroke that occurs in the most intense core of a thunderstorm with a positive polarity. Usually only occurs in severe storms and can only be detected in nearby storms (within 150 miles).

-CID – Negative Compact Inter-Cloud Discharge – Single stroke that occurs in the most intense core of a thunderstorm with a negative polarity. Usually only occurs in intense storms and can only be detected in nearby storms (within 150 miles).

Leader – Leader – Stroke that goes from the ground up. None have detected to this day on the detector. All cloud-to-grounds have them but they become part of the CG stroke.

Unknown – Unknown – Unidentified strokes of lightning.
